Craft Ideas

1. Door Hanger

You will need:

- Print out of hanger template (see below) either on card stock or onto paper and glue onto card
- Glue
- Scissors
- Pens/pencils/crayons
- Any other things, like stickers or glitter, to decorate

Instructions:

1. Colour picture and hearts and decorate as you wish.
2. Cut out hanger and hang on your door.
(optional: Decorate with glitter or ribbon or any other collage material).

2. Heart Hands

You will need:



- Piece of blank paper (any colour)
- Scissors
- Pens/pencils/crayons
- Stickers or other things to decorate hands




Instructions:

1. Place paper in front of you landscape (wide orientation).
2. Fold paper in half.
3. Place hand on paper and trace around making sure the thumb and the pointer finger are just overlapping at the fold of the paper.
4. Cut around hand shape making sure you don't cut all the way around thumb or pointer finger as that is where the paper needs to stay joined.
5. Unfold and you should have a heart shape with the fingers pointing down.
6. Colour and write the words "We have to be changed by God to be made right with God".

Game Ideas

1. Sneaking Through the City

Nicodemus went to find Jesus at night-time.

AIM: to get through the floor maze.

You will need:

- 12-16 pieces of blank paper (more or less pieces depending on how hard you'd like to make the maze)
- Spare blank piece

Instructions:

1. Lay out pieces of paper on floor in grid style leaving a small gap between each piece.
2. Draw on spare paper the grid and make up a path through the maze.
3. Pick a starting corner and get the kids to walk their way through the maze.
4. Kids step on 1 piece at a time. If they step on the correct paper (as in it's the path you have designed) then they can keep moving. If they stand on an incorrect piece of paper, then they have to go back to the start.
5. Person with maze solution on spare paper either says 'yes' or 'no' each time the kids step on each piece of paper on the floor.

Winner is first person to get through the maze

2. Eye Spy in the Dark

You will need:

- Torches (one per person or some to share)

Instructions:

1. Have room dark.
2. Choose a spying person
3. everyone else playing closes their eyes while the spying person shines their torch around the room till they've found an object.
4. other players can then shine their torches around the room and take turns saying the Eye Spy rhyme and guessing what the object is.
