1. Pray
2. Ensure the kids and parents in your church have access to the activity sheets and discussion questions & digging deeper devotionals. Feel free to offer these directly from your church website, attach them to an email to church families, print them out and deliver/post them, or encourage them to sign up themselves at <https://www.quizworx.com/resources/does-god-care>
3. Play the 'Does God Care?' video towards the start of your service, either by including in your live or pre-recorded service, or by sending families a link to watch on Vimeo.
4. During the sermon/teaching time for the adults, parents can encourage kids to work on the activity sheets.

# Digging Deeper

## Family Devotions



How to use 'Digging Deeper' for the 'Does God Care?' video.

To help you think more about how much God hears, God speaks, and God acts in Jesus, we have provided three devotions. We encourage you to read these passages with those in your household at a time that suits and use the questions to guide you as you talk about and reflect on Jesus this Christmas.

### Devotion 1 – Read Matthew 1:18-24

In this passage, God speaks to Joseph through an angel to tell him that his wife Mary will have a baby. And God would act powerfully through this very special baby!

1. What are some things we learn about Jesus? (Hint: 18, 21, 23)
2. Why do you think God chose to act in Jesus this way? (Hint 22-23, John 3:16)
3. Pick some words from the list below that help you describe how you feel about what God has done and share why you feel that way?
  - Joyful
  - Grateful
  - Hopeful
  - Peaceful
  - Surprised
  - Confused
  - Enthusiastic
  - Unsure

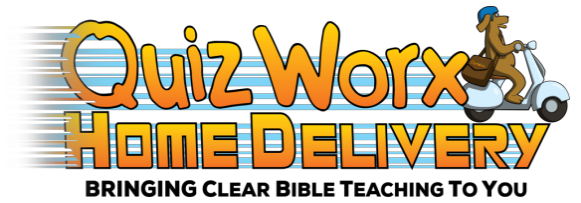
### Pray

Thank God that he keeps his promises and that he chose to show his love through Jesus.

Thank God that because of Jesus you can have a relationship with him. Ask God to help you praise him for this and share this Good News with others.

# Digging Deeper

## Family Devotions



### Devotion 2 – Read **John 1:1-18 & 13:34-35**

These verses help us see who Jesus is and what he came to do...

1. Jesus is described as the 'light' and the 'Word'. Why do you think John describes him this way?
2. What things does John say the light and the Word came to do?
3. What happens when someone accepts and puts their faith in Jesus? (John 1:12-13)
4. Looking at the second passage, how does God act through his people? (John 13:34-35). If you are a child of God, how could this change the way you live today?

#### Pray

Thank God that by trusting Jesus, we can have life that lasts forever with God.

Thank God that by trusting Jesus, we become children of God.

Ask God to help you love those around you and tell them about Jesus, the light, and the Word.

### Devotion 3 – Read **Hebrews 1:1-3**

This passage tells us about how God has spoken in the past and how he speaks now.

1. How has God spoken and how does he speak now? (vs 1-2)
2. How has God acted through Jesus?
3. Do you think God cares for you? Knowing that God acted and spoke through Jesus, what can you do in response to this?

#### Pray

Thank God for speaking to his people throughout time and for speaking to us now through Jesus.

Thank God for the Bible which tells us about Jesus.

Think of specific people in your life that you can show God's love and care to. Pray for them and ask God to help you to act.
